Subject- EU Regulation for construction materials (CPR) n. 305 /2011 issued by European Parliament and Council on the 09-03-2011.

According to the new regulation above mentioned as subject, since 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2013 all manufactures should issue a "Declaration of Performance" (DoP) for all products sold for the specific intended use.
